God is moving ... and leading us to a new location!

What is God doing?

From the beginning of our time at The Roxy Theatre, we have been seeking God's direction for the future. With the growth and development of Weekday Church, Weekend Church and the ministries that go along with them, we have been asking God to provide the space that is needed. We are excited to announce that God has opened a door for a new location for our Sunday morning services and additional ministry space for The Rock Church, right next door at City Centre Church!

What is new?

- **Ave G remains home** - The Rock Church at 228 Ave G South will continue to be our home base.
- **New ministry space leased** - City Centre Church is leasing us the second floor of their ministry center (701 20th Street West) for one year. We already rent this second-floor space weekly for Bibleville and choir rehearsals.
- **Sanctuary space secured** - They are also allowing us to rent their main sanctuary (720 20th Street West) for one of our Sunday morning services.

What are some of the key dates and timelines?

- **September 1, 2026** - We begin using City Centre Church second-floor facility (701 20th Street West).
- **November 1, 2026** - Sunday morning services officially move from The Roxy Theatre to the City Centre Church sanctuary (720 20th Street West).
- **October 31, 2027** - The one-year experiment concludes and we will review the partnership with City Centre Church to determine the path forward.

When and where will our services happen?

- **9 a.m. at City Center Church** - 720 20th Street West (our current Roxy service)
- **11 a.m. at The Rock Church** - 228 Ave G South (our current 9 a.m. service)

Will the services be the same?

- The services will continue in their current unique formats ...
 - 9:00 a.m. service looking like the current 10:00 a.m. service
 - 11:00 a.m. service looking like the current 9:00 a.m. service

Will there be TRC kids?

- Yes, for both services
 - 9 a.m. service - Full ministry
 - 11 a.m. service - As need develops

Why are we doing this?

- This will double our current space for ministry, for approximately the same amount we currently pay in rent for Sunday mornings and Wednesday evenings.
- We get full time access to the top floor of City Centre (701-20th Street), which is 10,500 sq feet of ministry space.
- We get Sunday morning access to the sanctuary at 720 20th W Saskatoon for our 9 a.m service.

Why are we doing this? (con't)

- The two Sunday services and TRC Kids locations will be close together.
- Sundays will no longer require setting up from scratch.
- We would have access to additional office space.

This seems so sudden – are we sure God is leading in this direction?

- We can appreciate that it may *feel* sudden but the elders have been talking about what to do about our facility for over a year and have been in negotiations with City Centre for the last few months.
- We are grateful for the favour God has given us with City Centre Church and the relationship we have with them. We are thankful for the trust they have put in us to share their facility with us. And we desire to honor that and be a blessing to them.
- We see God's hand and timing in this.

What's the end goal with all these changes?

- We expand our opportunities to be ***Bringing Hope to Life*** while we love, grow, rest and serve.
- We want to be faithful to follow God's leading and provision for facilities in this next season.

Is this move permanent?

- We will enter this one-year experiment with open hands, not looking for success or failure but rather as a chance to learn and be faithful to how God is leading us and see what He has for us.

Can we still have fellowship times?

- Yes - we will try some new things:) For example, we may have a Connections Brunch instead of a Connections Lunch ... and use our indoor and outdoor spaces in creative ways.

Why is City Centre Street willing to lease us their building?

- The second floor is currently available to lease and they desire it be used for God's kingdom.
- We have been renting space at City Centre Church for Weekday Church and choir practice for more than two years.
- City Centre Church is willing to move their own service to 11:15 a.m. to make space for our 9:00 a.m. Sunday morning service.

Is this a good use of money?

- Yes – we believe this is a great investment for a relatively small increase in cost. We will gain significantly more space and more opportunities to serve our church and reach people in our city.
- Leasing the City Centre Church locations will cost us just 18% more money than we currently spend on rental space and give us approximately 536% more time in the new space ... (yes, over 500% more time is available for ministry in buildings for the money we spend!)

How should I be praying for all this?

- Pray for clear communication and understanding of all the changes.
- Pray for wisdom as we make decisions and work out logistics.

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
